- CLASS:** The 8-Metre Euro Cup will be sailed for the Int. Eight Metre Class in the divisions:
8-Metre Class, division: Modern (year of construction: 1967 – 2010)
8-Metre Class, division: Classic (1920 – 1966) and
8-Metre Class, division: First Rule (1907 – 1919)
A division consist of a minimum of 3 yachts. In case of fewer yachts being registered the Organizing Authority may score divisions together.
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** 15 May 2010
- RACING AREA:** Races will be sailed on the Kiel Bay and Kiel Fjord.

- REGISTRATION:** 30 June 2010: 12.00 – 18.00 hrs in the Race Office
- SCHEDULE RACES:** 1 – 4 July 2010: 1 – 3 races each day. The 8-Metre EuroCup consists of a maximum number of nine races.
- FIRST / LAST START SIGNAL:** 1 July 2010: 11.00 hrs / 4 July 2010: 14.00 hrs
- FORMAT:** Windward/Leeward or triangle or similar short distance races for up to three races daily. Due to weather conditions the Race Committee may change format and racing area. Changes will be published on the official notice board.
- BERTHING:** Düsternbrook Marina, Basin IV, in front of the Kieler Yacht-Club.
- RACE OFFICE:** The Race Office will be located inside the clubhouse of Kieler Yacht-Club (KYC). It will be open daily from 30 June – 4 July 2010 at 08.00 hrs.

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by

- the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS).
- prescriptions of the national authority, the Deutscher Segler-Verband (DSV),
- The Rating Rule and Measurement Instructions of the International Eight Metre Class except as altered below.

1.2. Rules for the International 8-Metre class will be altered as follows:

1.2.1. Yachts built prior to January 1, 1960 with no hull modifications as defined by IEMA are permitted a maximum measurement of 8.07 metres, using the rating formula of the Class Rule. Such yachts shall have otherwise valid measurement certificates. The owners shall submit a signed statement that no hull modifications or ballast changes, which would affect the rating, have been made since the last measurement.

1.2.2. The maximum number of crew may be increased to seven (7) for all yachts designed prior to 1960. All yachts shall be required to declare their crew number and names at registration and sail with that number throughout the regatta. All yachts may register one alternative crew on their crew list. This crew may be used by registering the crew change by 19.00 hrs at the Race Office on the day before the crew change is to take place. Any additional crew changes shall be approved by the International Jury.

1.2.3. All Yachts must carry the prescribed safety equipment on board in accordance with the yacht's country of registry. All Yachts must carry a towline of minimum 15-metre length and life jackets available for every crewmember during the race.

2. ADVERTISING AND BOW STICKERS

2.1. The restrictions set out in Class Rule 36 apply, no advertising on mainsail and genoa.

2.2. Advertising according to ISAF Regulation 20 apply.

2.3. Each boat may be required to display event advertising on the first 20 percent of hull length and backstay flags at any time from 30 June until 4 July. While not racing, all boats are strongly urged to fly the event flag from the forestay. Bow decals and backstay flags and event flags will be supplied by the Operating Organizer at registration. Every effort shall be made to retain the decals on the bows.

3. MEDIA

3.1. Media facilities will be provided on-site at the race venue in Kiel. All visiting media representatives will be welcome provided they are properly accredited. The accreditation form will be available for downloading approximately six weeks prior to the event on www.regattanews.com.
